#### **GUIDELINES FOR ORAL PRESENTATION**

1. The presenter is required to wear semi - formal attire.

2. A PowerPoint presentation of not more than eight (8) slides is required. The slides should contain the following:

1st Slide: Title, Name/s of the Author/s, and Institutional Affiliation

2<sup>nd</sup> Slide: Research gap/s that led to the formulation/conceptualization of the study

3rd Slide: Statement of the Problem/Objectives

4<sup>th</sup> Slide: Methodology (This could be presented through diagram/illustration; Discuss in detail during the presentation the pertinent steps that were undertaken in the study and the employed research techniques, methods, approaches, and designs.)

5th-6th Slides: Salient Findings

7<sup>th</sup> Slide: Conclusions (Highlight the implications of the findings not the summary of the findings)

8th Slide: Recommendations/Limitations of the Study

3. The presenter is given five (5) to seven (7) minutes to present his/her paper. Present only the highlights of the study so that it can be accommodated on the given time.

3.a. The presenter may choose to present live or via video recording in MP4 format.

3.b. If the presenter chose to present via pre-recorded video, he/she should send the video on or before September 19, 2024 at <a href="mailto:saritaan2023@gmail">saritaan2023@gmail</a>; he/she should be present during the conference.

4. For multiple authors in the study, only one is allowed to present the paper.

- 5. After three presenters are done, Question and Answer (Q & A) follow. Only two to three questions will be asked to each presenter. Three (3) minutes will be given to each presenter to answer the questions. With this, participants are encouraged to ask questions to the presenter.
- 6. Presenters will be notified by either the timer or the moderator for the remaining time of the presentation.
- 7. All presenters shall stay throughout the sessions of the research presentation. Exceptions are given to those who have other presentation on the other breakout rooms.
- 8. Certificates of Presentation and Attendance will be given only to those who will complete the 2-day conference; at the same vein you will be given the link for evaluation to claim the certificates. It is to note that attendance links will be given every after session.
