REGIONAL ROVER ORIENTATION, VIGIL AND INVESTITURE CEREMONY


To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Education Supervisors Unit and Section Heads Public and Private School Heads All Others Concerned

- 1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 12, s. 2024, the Boy Scouts of the Philippines Region 1 announces the conduct of the Regional Rover Orientation Vigil and Investiture Ceremony at San Fernando City South Central School, Tanqui, San Fernando City, La Union on September 20, 2024 which starts at 6:00 in the afternoon.
- The activity aims to:
 - a. provide an overview of the Rover Scouting program, including its aim, principles and activities helping the participants understand its purpose
 - b. to conduct the official investiture of new Rover Scouts, symbolizing their readiness to uphold the Scouts Promise and Law and actively participate in scouting at a higher level; and
 - c. to strengthen camaraderie among Rovers by promoting teamwork and collaboration through various groups and activities.
- The registration fee for the activity is three hundred pesos (P 300.00) for all young interested people aged 16 to 24, while those who are 25 and above shall pay three hundred fifty pesos (P350.00) to cover the registration fee of fifty pesos, one hundred pesos for the neckerchief and slide, fifty pesos worth breakfast, and the rest of the amount is for miscellaneous expenses.
- All attendees are advised to bring their packed dinner, bottle of water, ballpen, white t-shirt for the investiture ceremony, and umbrella or poncho. Likewise, participants are expected to bring rover thumbstick which is a long small branch of a tree with the letter y in its end. An end of a bamboo may do as well.
- Coastal clean-up follows after breakfast as the 1st advancement activity of the rover scouts who shall be invested.
- All participants are expected to be on-time. For other concerns, refer to Ms. Marie Camille S. Hufana through cellular phone number 0917-5355525 or to Ms. Imelda S. Samson through 0918-9596552.
- Deadline for submission of intent to participate in the said activity shall be on or before September 16, 2024 at 5:00 PM to the Division Boy Scouts of the Philippines coordinator, Ms. Gladys B. Lampitoc.

REGIONAL ROVER ORIENTATION, VIGIL & INVESTITURE CEREMONY

- We are pleased to announce the conduct of the Regional Rover Orientation, Vigil and Investiture Ceremony to be held at San Fernando City South Central School, Tanqui, San Fernando City, La Union on 20 September 2024. It will commence at 1800hrs.
- The regional vigil was requested by the Deputy Regional Program Commissioner for Rover Scouting who initiated the activity as her 1st step in increasing the number of Rover Scouts in the region. She opted to benchmark the activity in the SDO of San Fernando City under La Union Council.
- 3. The registration fee for the activity is three hundred pesos (P 300,00) for all interested young people aged 16 to 24, while those who are 25 and above shall pay three hundred fifty pesos (P 350,00) to cover the registration fee of fifty pesos and one hundred pesos, neckerchief, and slide, breakfast worth fifty pesos and miscellaneous expense.
- The registration fee shall be forwarded to the local councils from where the participants are coming from, the rover neckerchief shall be taken from the National Office while the remaining amount shall be for breakfast, candles, and other expenses of the activity.
- 5. The registration fee shall be collected upon arrival at the venue. As the event will commence at 1800hrs, we advise all attendees to bring their packed dinner and bring their bottle of water and ballipen. All are further advised to bring a white T-shirt for the investiture ceremony. As the weather is uncertain, all are advised to bring either an umbrella or poncho to protect themselves from the trek.
- While doing the trek, participants are expected to have with them the rover thumbstick, which is a long small branch of a tree with the letter y in its end. An end of a bamboo may do as well.

- Immediately after breakfast, Coastal Clean-up in shall follow as the 1st advancement activity
 of the rover scouts who shall be invested. All participants of the coastal clean-up shall be
 listed and submitted for recording purposes.
- The time is essential, so we expect all to be at the venue on time. For other concerns, you

- Deadline for submission of intent to participate shall be on 18 September 2024 to provide ample time to buy the much-needed materials for the scouting event.
