





- The purpose of this celebration is to emphasize the importance of technicalvocational education through providing a platform for the exchange of information, updates, and sharing of best practices related to technical-vocational education programs. It also serves to promote and raise awareness of the various technicalvocational education offerings available in schools such as Edukasyong Pantahanan at Pangkabuhayan/ Technology and Livelihood Education (EPP/TLE), Senior High School-Technical-Vocational-Livelihood (SHS-TVL) Track, Immersion Program, Special Program in Technical-Vocational Education (SPTVE), and Rural Farm School (RFS).
- For this year, with the DepEd's theme: "Tech-Voc Tungo sa Pag-unlad at Pagbangon; Angking Talino at Kakayahan, Linangin at Isulong," the activities will be held from August 19 to 31, 2024.
