



2024 SEARCH FOR OUTSTANDING RED CROSS YOUTH COUNCIL

I. Minimum Qualification Requirements

a. Awardees of the Outstanding Red Cross Youth Councils shall come from, Junior Red Cross, Senior Red Cross Youth, Senior Plus Red Cross Youth, College Red Cross Youth, and Community Red Cross Youth based on the following separate categories;

Youth School/Community Population

a. 1. Small

1-300

a. 2. Medium

301--2000

a. 3. Large

2001 and above

- b. Must have an organized Red Cross Youth Council;
- c. Must have an existing and implementing Constitution and By-Laws;
- d. Must have a Council Officers who have completed the Leadership Development Program with existing Membership Accident Assurance Benefit; and
- e. Must have implemented at least two (2) projects or programs under Philippine Red Cross Youth program within the fiscal year after their councils have been accredited by PRC.

AI. Requirements for Nominees

- a. All documents for submission must be in A4 sized bond paper.
- b. Two (2) copies of duly accomplished nomination forms inclusive of all documents in sequential order:

III. The Search Process

- a. Submission of nominations shall be open to ALL accredited by the RCY councils.
- b. Nominations must be received by the Red Cross Youth Excellence Awards Secretariat within the set due date that shall be announced.
- c. The RCY Committee shall intensively review all the documents and attachments sent. Should there be any missing, unverified, or incomplete document or attachment, the nomination package shall be considered null and void and will not be subjected to further screening.
- d. The RCY Committee Screening committee shall identify ten (10) finalists for the Outstanding Red Cross Chapter Youth Council (ORCY) finalists they shall be informed through a formal correspondence to the chapter.
- e. The ten (10) RCYC finalists shall prepare a video presentation of their Red Cross Youth Council featuring the council and the project that they indicated in the nomination package.
- f. After all the scores have been recorded, a panel shall deliberate as to who shall be named as the Outstanding Red Cross Youth Councils.
- g. The deadline of submission shall be on or before November 6, 2024.
- h. The scope of nomination is August 2022- October 2024.

- b. A resident of Ilocos Norte
- c. Must be 10-30 years old on the date of submission of the nomination package:
- d. An active Red Cross Youth volunteer who have excelled and contributed to the organization for at least two (2) years and must be enrolled in the Membership Accident Assurance Benefit Program;
- e. Must exemplify outstanding participation and involvement as an RCY volunteer in academics, co-curricular and extra-curricular;
- f. Must has no failing grades as reflected in academic documents;
- g. Must have spearheaded and implemented at least one innovative (1) project under the Red Cross Youth (completed or ongoing);
- h. Must be strictly come from an accredited and active Red Cross Youth Council School/Community Council;
- i. Must completed the Leadership Development Program (LDP) and have undergone First Aid Training;
- Has not been subjected to any disciplinary case in campus nor has been charged and/or convicted in a civil or criminal case;
- k. As entry points, the Red Cross Youth Nominees must get at least 50 points in the criteria for outstanding.



 - 4. Certificates Scanned copy of MAAB ID
 - 5. Project Background and Impact (implemented project) Red Cross Youth Achievement Profile



III. The Search Process

- a. Submission of nominations shall be open to all qualified individuals. However, each school must nominate RCY eligible for the award only.
- b. Application forms and all the nominees requirements must be submitted in PRC Ilocos Norte Chapter.
- c. The RCY Committee and Awards Committee shall intensively review all documents and attachment, the nomination package shall be considered null and void and will not be subjected for further screening.
- d. The RCY Committee and Awards Committee shall identify ten (10) finalists for the Outstanding Red Cross Youth. The finalists shall be informed through a formal correspondence to the nominee's school/community, and the nominee.
- e. The ten (10) finalists shall be subjected for a panel interview by distinguished individuals.
- f. After all the finalists have been interviewed, the secretariat shall tabulate their final scores and the panel of interviewers shall deliberate as to who shall be named as the Outstanding Red Cross Youth.
- g. The deadline of submission shall be on or before November 6, 2024.
- h. The scope of nomination is August 2022- October 2024.

- b. Place of work assignment is within Ilocos Norte
- c. Recognized as RCY adviser to a particular school or community/Brgy. within the province of Ilocos Norte
- d. An active Red Cross Youth adviser volunteer who has excelled and contributed to the organization for at least two (2) years and must be enrolled in the Membership Accident Assurance Benefit Program;
- e. Must have spearheaded and implemented at least one innovative (1) project under the Red Cross Youth (completed or ongoing);
- f. Must have his/her council accredited by PRC and active Red Cross Youth Council (School-Based or community based).
- g. Has not been subjected to any disciplinary case in campus nor has been charged and/or convicted in a civil or criminal case.
- **h.** As entry points, the Adviser Nominee must get at least 50 points in the criteria for outstanding.


