LEADERSHIP CAMP CUM DIVISION LEARNERS' CONVERGENCE 2024

Assistant Schools Division Superintendent To: Chief Education Supervisors Unit and Section Heads Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads All Others Concerned

- The Schools Division of the City of Batac (SDCB) will conduct a Leadership Camp Cum Division Learners' Convergence (DLC) on October 23-24, 2024, at the SDCB Conference Hall.
- The conduct of the DLC 2024 aims to develop students' leadership skills and abilities for effectively leading change, resolving conflict, and motivating others as guided the four (4) core values of DepEd which will prepare them to become responsible, sensible and competent leaders of the community and the country. Specifically, it aims to:

a. provide a comprehensive understanding of the functions, duties, and ethical considerations required for effective school leadership;

b. create a platform for sharing successful initiatives and programs that can be adapted and implemented in other schools;

c. encourage student leaders to connect, collaborate, and develop solutions to common challenges faced in their respective schools; and

- d. provide opportunities for developing essential skills such as communication, teamwork, and problem-solving, contributing to both personal and professional growth.
- The participants to this two-day activity are the identified teacher-advisers and learner-leaders of the different public elementary and secondary schools of the Schools Division of the City of Batac (see enclosures for reference).
- 4. Participation in the DLC 2024 shall be purely voluntary and will not hamper instructional time pursuant to the provisions set in DO 003, s. 2024 and DO 022, s. 2023 titled Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities.
- The newly elected officers of both the Division Federated Elementary and Secondary Learner Governments will take their oath of office during the event..
- Parental consent and waiver are required for participating learners and must be submitted at the registration (copy attached).
- Expenses in the conduct of the activity shall be charged against the 2024 Special Education Fund: Learning Support Services Programs- Leadership Training for Youth Leaders of the City Government of Batac subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
