### ILOCOS REGION SCOUT JAMBOREE

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Education Supervisors Unit and Section Heads Public and Private Elementary School Heads Public and Private Secondary School Heads All Others Concerned

- Pursuant to Regional Office Memorandum Number 17, s. 2024, the Boy Scouts of the Philippines- Ilocos Region will be conducting the Ilocos Region Scout Jamboree with the theme BSP Elevate @ 88: Futureproofing Scouting for the Next Century & Beyond on December 11-15, 2024 in Saud, Badoc, Ilocos Norte.
- The 6th Regional Jamboree aims to provide the participants with progressive, challenging, exciting, and purposeful activities to develop the scouts' full physical, mental, social, emotional, and spiritual potentials. Specifically, the activities are designed to:

a. cater to requirements for advancement;

- b. familiarize the scouts with the rich cultural heritage of the Municipality of Badoc;
- c. contribute to the development of the community through community service projects; and
- d. appreciate and preserve nature through the World Programs and discover the scouts' talents through arena show.
- The Schools Division of the City of Batac (SDCB) supports the said activity with the aim of producing competent scout leaders and responsible youth citizens in the division.
- Participants are open to all who meet the given qualifications set in Regional Office Memorandum No. 17, s. 2024 herein attached.
- A registration fee of five hundred pesos (Php 500.00) will be charged from each participant to cover expenses for souvenir items (ID lace, neckerchief, patch), program materials, logistics, and other administrative expenses.
- The deadline for the payment of the pre-registration of two hundred pesos (Php 200.00) is on or before November 30, 2024 and payment must be directly deposited in the account of Ilocos Norte – Laoag City Council. Pre-registration fees are non-refundable but transferable.
- Jamboree expenses in line with the participation in the jamboree may be charged against scouting funds, and Special Educations Funds (SEF) subject to its availability and approval.
- All attendees are advised to bring big water containers, electrical wiring (limited to utilization of bulbs), tentage, and other camping equipment.
- 9. Service Credits and Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) equivalent to two (2) days shall be granted to the teaching and non-teaching personnel who will participate in the






2. The 6<sup>th</sup> Regional Jamboree aims to provide the participants with progressive, challenging, exciting, and purposeful activities to develop their full physical, mental, social, emotional, and spiritual potentials.

Activities are designed to 1)cater to requirements for advancement, 2)familiarize the scouts with the rich cultural heritage of the Municipality of Badoc, 3) contribute to the development of the community through community service projects 4)appreciate & preserve nature through the World Programs and discover the scouts talents through arena show.

3. Participation: The Jamboree is open to all provided that they meet the following qualifications:

Boy Scouts: Must be registered, physically fit for the activities as certified by a licensed physician, have parents/guardian permit allowing his participation, and attended either a school backyard camping or district camporal.

Senior Scouts: Must be registered, physically fit for the activities as certified by a licensed physician, have parents/guardian permit allowing his participation and attended school backyard camping

Rover Scouts: registered scout whose age is 16-24, physically fit for the activities, have parents/guardians permit and attended community service projects and are willing to serve in various activities as Jamboree support staff

Unit Leaders: Must be registered, preferably Basic Training Course graduate, served as Unit Leader for at least two years, physically fit as certified by a licensed physician

Contingent Management Team: Local Councils shall organize their contingent management team to ensure smooth and orderly participation of their contingent. These are but not limited to the following: Contingent Head, Deputy Contingent Heads for Program Administration, Activity Officer, Health and Safety, Transportation, Physical Arrangement, and General Services.

Activity/Program Staff: Local councils will be assigned to handle the different modules. The Council Scout Executives shall be responsible for recruiting the members of the modules assigned to them putting into consideration the experience in facilitating the activities.

The regional office, however, would appoint program staff to serve as focal persons for the activities. The list will be issued together with the assigned modules.

- 4. The deadline for the payment of the pre-registration of two hundred pesos (Php200.00) is on or before 30 November 2024 and payment must be directly deposited in the account of Ilocos Norte-Laoac City Council. Pre-registration fees are non-refundable but transferable.
- 5. Contingents are advised to bring big water containers, electrical wiring (limited to utilization of bulbs), tentage, and other camping equipment.
- Jamboree expenses in line with the participation in the jamboree may be charged against scouting funds, and special education funds subject to its availability and approval.

All concerned are enjoined to seek support from local government units utilizing the provision of **DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2018-11 dated 30 January 2018.** 

- 7. DepEd School Teachers shall be given corresponding days of service credits, while compensatory time off (CTO) for non-teaching personnel according to the provision of the DepEd Order No. 76 series of 2012.
