#### **DIVISION KINDERGARTEN FESTIVAL**

Assistant Schools Division Superintendent To: Chief Education Supervisors Unit and Section Heads Public and Private Elementary School Heads All Others Concerned

- 1. The Schools Division of the City of Batac through the Curriculum Implementation Division shall conduct the Division Kindergarten Festival at Hilario Valdez Memorial Elementary School on November 15, 2024 at 8:00 a.m to 5:00 p.m.
- 2. The activity aims to:

a. showcase learners' talents, skills and creativity; and

- b. promote desirable values such as honesty, sportsmanship, teamwork and social interaction among the learners.
- Participants to the festival are Kindergarten learners. Each school is allowed only one contestant per activity, except for dance. Contests will be held simultaneously, so only one contestant per activity is permitted. Participants are required to bring their own drawing materials.
- The top 5 winners of each contested activity will receive certificates of 4. recognition and medals acknowledging their outstanding achievements. Additionally, all participants will receive certificates of participation, celebrating their valuable contribution and effort in the event.
- Contestants and teacher-coaches are provided with school supplies, office materials, and free snacks. The expenses for this activity are funded by the Special Education Fund (SEF) of the City of Batac.
- The decision of the board of judges is final and irrevocable. 6.

#### **Enclosure No. 1 Guidelines on the Contested Activities**

(Theme: Talento ken Laing Pabilgen, Natibker a Pundasyon Namnamaen)

### a. Daniw (Poem Recitation)

- It should revolve around the main theme.
- There is only one Ilokano piece for all contestants.
- Participants are permitted to use props which can enhance their presentations and performances.

#### b. Draw and Tell

- There is only one learner assigned to do the Draw and Tell.
- The allotted time for drawing is one hour.
- Use oslo paper in landscape orientation.
- Use Crayola 8-color crayons. Do not include margins and use of patterns is not allowed.
- For the "Tell" portion, use the Ilokano language and include 3 to 5 sentences.

### c. Singing

- The song should be appropriate for children and can be in any
- Using a minus one track is allowed.

### d. Dancing

- The team consists of five to eight members.
- Use modern dance music that is suitable for children.
- The music should be 3 to 5 minutes long, including both entrance and exit.
