REITERATION OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE UNDISTURBED INSTRUCTIONAL ENGAGEMENT BETWEEN TEACHERS AND LEARNERS FOR **SCHOOL YEAR 2024-2025**

- The Department of Education Regional Office I reiterates the Regional Memorandum No. 1479, s. 2024 titled Implementing the Undisturbed Instructional Engagement Between Teachers and Learners for School Year 2024-2025.
- 2. The provisions stated in RM 1479, s. 2024 are still in effect. Thus, all schoolbased activities, both curricular and non-curricular, are prohibited to prioritize contact hours for the effective delivery of core curriculum content.
- Schools have been reported to schedule extracurricular and non-curricular 3. activities beyond regular hours and during weekends. While this approach appears to align with the provisions of the regional memorandum, the preparation and rehearsals for these activities are often conducted during class hours, potentially disrupting regular instruction.
- Thus, if schools intend to conduct activities beyond class hours or on weekends, no preparation, rehearsal, or related activity shall be done that may interrupt the regular class schedule. Instead, all preparations and rehearsals must also be conducted beyond class hours or weekends, subject to existing DepEd and CSC rules and regulations.
- Additionally, learners participating in activities outside regular schedules shall be required to secure parental consent. School heads and personnel shall exercise extraordinary diligence or the highest degree of care to ensure safety of learners participating in activities scheduled beyond class hours.



- The Department of Education Regional Office I reiterates the Regional Memorandum No. 1479, s. 2024 titled Implementing the Undisturbed Instructional Engagement Between Teachers and Learners for School Year 2024-2025.
- The provisions stated in RM 1479, s. 2024 are still in effect. Thus, all school-based activities, both curricular and non-curricular, are prohibited to prioritize contact hours for the effective delivery of core curriculum content.
- Schools have been reported to schedule extracurricular and non-curricular activities beyond regular class hours and during weekends. While this approach appears to align with the provisions of the regional memorandum, the preparation and rehearsals for these activities are often conducted during class hours, potentially disrupting regular instruction.
- Thus, if schools intend to conduct activities beyond class hours or on weekends, no preparation, rehearsal, or related activity shall be done that may interrupt the regular class schedule. Instead, all preparations and rehearsals must also be conducted beyond class hours or weekends, subject to existing DepEd and CSC rules and regulations.
- 5. Additionally, learners participating in activities outside regular schedules shall be required to secure parental consent. School heads and personnel shall exercise extraordinary diligence or the highest degree of care to ensure safety of learners participating in activities scheduled beyond class hours.


