1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 47, s. 2024, titled "Constitution and By-Laws of the Supreme Pupil Government and Supreme Student Government in Elementary and Secondary Schools, the Department recognizes the Learner Government Program (LGP) – formerly the Student Government Program (SGP) – as the primary co-curricular, learner-led organization authorized to implement programs, projects, and activities in all schools nationwide.

2. The elections for the Supreme Elementary Learner Government (SELG) and Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG) play a crucial role in cultivating leadership skills and empowering learners to actively engage in school governance. These elections not only offer learners the chance to take on leadership responsibilities but also emphasize the importance of learner-led organizations in strengthening a dynamic and inclusive school environment.

3. As part of the preparations for School Year (S.Y.) 2025-2026, the SELG and SSLG elections will be conducted after the 3rd quarter examinations of S.Y. 2024-2025, adhering to the schedule outlined below:

Division Elections	March 5-6, 2025
Regional Federation Elections	March 17-28, 2025
National Federation Elections	TBA

4. Also, pending the approval of the revised Constitution and By-Laws of the Learner Government Program (LGP), schools are hereby advised to adhere to the guidelines stipulated in the previously issued official issuances:

- OUOPS Memo No. 2023-03 – Interim Guidelines of the Learner Government Program (LGP) for School Year 2023-2024
- DM-OUOPS-2024-11-02487 – Schedule of the Supreme Elementary Learner Government (SELG) and Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG) Elections for School Year 2024-2025

5. Implementing schools are mandated to adhere to the prescribed guidelines. However, they are encouraged to refine or enhance these guidelines through a formal resolution to ensure alignment with the unique context and needs of the school.

6. Furthermore, the scheduled division election will include an orientation session and the development of School General Plans of Action (GPOA). Further details will be provided in a separate memorandum.

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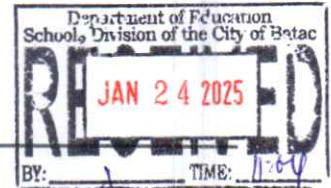
