

Rice Mosaic Art Contest Guidelines

Theme: Better Rice Communities

Contest Date and Time:

Date: 26 February 2025
Time: 1:00-4:30PM
Venue: NTA-PhilRice Gallery

Eligibility

The contest is open to teams of three members.

Contestants must be from selected high school students in the City of Batac.

 No prior experience in rice mosaic art is required, but creativity and resourcefulness are encouraged.

Materials

Required Materials:

- Rice (various colors may be used, but the majority should be regular white rice and rice grains).
- Glue (adhesive for attaching rice to the board).

Optional Materials (for enhancement):

- Natural dyes or paint for coloring rice (in moderation).
- Scissors (for cutting rice if needed) and other basic tools.
- Forceps

Board Specifications

- Each team will be provided with a board canvas (approximately 50x40 cm working area with 1-inch borders).
- The entire artwork must fit within the boundaries of the board.

Judging Criteria

- 1. Creativity & Originality (30 points)
 - Unique and fresh interpretation of the theme.
 - Innovative use of rice and other materials.
- 2. Relevance to Theme (25 points)
 - Strong connection to the theme "Better Rice Communities"
 - Clear message about the positive impact or vision for rice communities.
- 3. Aesthetic Appeal (25 points)
 - Visual impact and beauty of the artwork.
 - Use of color, design, and composition to create an eye-catching piece.
- 4. Technical Skill (20 points)
 - Precision in placing rice, neatness, and well-executed techniques.

Contest Rules

- Time Limit: Each team has 3 hours to complete their artwork. Late submissions will not be accepted.
- Team Work: Only three members per team. Collaboration and teamwork are essential for the successful completion of the piece.
- 3. Materials Usage: Rice must be the primary material used in the mosaic. Additional materials should complement the rice theme.
- Work Environment: Participants must maintain cleanliness during the contest. Dispose of waste materials properly.



Final Submission: Artwork must be submitted by the end of the 3-hour period. The piece should be fully completed and on the provided board.

General Guidelines

- Arrival: All teams should arrive 30 minutes before the start of the contest for registration and setup.
- 2. Safety & Cleanliness: Ensure that the workspace is kept clean and free of any hazards. All participants must use the materials provided responsibly.
- 3. Respect the Theme: Ensure that the artwork aligns with the theme "Better Rice Communities." The piece should reflect the positive aspects of rice farming communities.
- 4. Judging Transparency: The judges' decisions are final, and the artwork cannot be modified once the submission is closed.
- 5. Behavior: Participants are expected to behave respectfully throughout the event, keeping the competition friendly and enjoyable for all.
