

## CAREER TALK ON MICROBIOLOGY For Senior High School Students CONTEST GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS March 24, 2025 | Center for Flexible Learning, MMSU

Microbiology is a dynamic, fascinating and essential science that offers countless opportunities to make a real difference in the world. Thus, Career talk on Microbiology has been an advocacy for the Philippine Society for Microbiology-Inc. and Philippine Society for Microbiology-Northern Luzon chapter.

This career talk caters Senior High School students in the Ilocos region. There will be 3 resource speakers from the national and regional chapter officers.

After the career talk, the 5th microbiology quiz show, elimination round will follow.

### 5<sup>th</sup> MICROBIOLOGY QUIZ SHOW For Senior High School Students CONTEST GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS March 24, 2025 | Center for Flexible Learning, MMSU

### Pre-registration

- The contest is open to all Senior High School students from various schools in Northern Luzon and in the Ilocos Region.
- Each school may send two (2) participants ONLY with ONE coach. Each participant shall pay a
  registration fee of three hundred pesos (₱300.00) only to defray expenses, via Gcash to the
  account name Alice Geraldine H. Pagaling, 09085952400.
- After payment, each participant shall register on or before February 28, 2025 via https://shorturl.at/MWVJc
- 4. The link opens a form that requires the participant's personal information and payment details.
- Once registered, each participant is advised to contact Mr. Junel A. Biding (Corresponding Secretary) at 09272803199 and Ms. Alice Geraldine H. Pagaling (Recording Secretary) at 09085952400, to be recognized and added to a Facebook Messenger Group Conversation (GC) for announcements, updates and instructions about this event.
- Participants shall be joining the contest face-to-face. The elimination round shall be held on March 24, 2025, 10:00 in the morning to 12:00 noon immediately after the Career talk on Microbiology.
- On the same day, ten (10) top scorers only shall be announced during the Final Round that runs from 1:00 to 5:00 in the afternoon.

### Elimination Round

- The Elimination Round shall be a written examination with fifty (50) multiple choice type questions only.
- b. Participants shall be given one (1) hour to answer all questions to finish this round.
- c. Participants shall use black or blue permanent ink pens only to write their answers. Pencils or erasable ink pens are not allowed.
- d. Any form of cheating is ground for disqualification.
- e. Right after all entries are checked and scored, ten (10) top ranking scorers in the Elimination Round shall be announced immediately to qualify for the Final Round.

### Final Round

- a. The Final Round shall follow a quiz show format.
- b. The Championship Round shall consist of three (3) categories with ten (10) questions each namely, "Easy", "Average", and "Difficult".

- c. The types of questions shall include Multiple Choice, True or False, Fill in the Blanks, and Identification.
- d. A scoring system shall be followed to assign numerical values or "points" to each correct answer to a question depending on the category, as shown in the table below:

Category	Point/s	
Easy	1	
Average	3	
Difficult	5	

- e. Any answer that is synonymous with or similar to the announced correct answer shall be considered only upon the approval of the Board of Judges that shall be composed the officers of the PSM-NL Chapter and the PSM, Inc.
- Each participant shall be given up to 15, 20, and 30 seconds to answer each question during the Easy, Average and Difficult categories, respectively.
- g. Each question shall be read twice only by the Quiz Master.
- h. Each participant is only allowed to write the answer after the Quiz Master has read the question.
- When the time is up, all participants who answered correctly shall raise their answer boards, otherwise they will not be counted for scoring.
- j. At the end of every category, scores are summed and announced.
- k. Five (5) top scorers shall be declared top placers ranked according to cumulative number of points, i.e. first, second, third, fourth, and fifth placers.
- In case of a tie among the four top scorers or succeeding ones, a clincher round shall break the
  tie with three (3) questions of different difficulties. The participant who earns the most number of
  points wins this round.
- m. If this round fails, a "Do or Die" question shall be given. The first participant to answer correctly wins.
- Ten (10) top scorers ranking 6th to 10th will each receive certificates of recognition as "Top 10 Finalist".
- o. Top 4 and 5 will be given a certificate of recognition and a consolation prize of ₱500.00.
- p. Tops 1, 2, and 3 will be awarded with a certificate of recognition and cash prices of \$\mathbb{P}\$2500.00, \$\mathbb{P}\$1500.00, and \$\mathbb{P}\$1000.00, respectively.
- q. Noteworthy, all coaches of the top 10 will be given a certificate of recognition.

It shall contain the title, name/s of author/s, affiliation/s, a body of up to two hundred (200) words ONLY, and keyword/s.

The deadline for submission shall be February 20, 2025.

Once oral or poster presentation entries are accepted, the author/s will be notified. They shall submit to the PSM-NL secretariat at psm\_nl18@yahoo.com their expanded abstract in the same format (pdf) with

SURNAME>\_EXPANDED\_ORAL2025 (for oral presentation); and
SURNAME>\_EXPANDED\_POSTER2025 (for poster presentation).

The deadline for submission shall be February 29, 2025.

A panel of evaluators will choose the top three poster and oral presenters.

The representing author of the winning entries will be recognized in the closing cere
and will receive a certificate of recognition and cash prizes.
