a. provide the need and the clamour for youth participation in the decision making process of the organization;



- All registered senior scouts at least fifteen years old (Grade 9 Grade 11) with good oral and written communication skills from public and private secondary schools of the Schools Division of the City of Batac are encouraged to participate in the activity, provided that their participation does not interfere with the conduct of classes in schools and any regular functions and responsibilities.
- A registration fee of one thousand pesos (Php 1, 000.00) shall be charged to each participant to defray expenses for the food (2 breakfast, 2 lunch, 2 dinner and 3 snacks), forum materials and other administrative cost.
- Expenses in line with the participation in the jamboree may be charged against local and scouting funds subject to its availability and approval.
- Service Credits and Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) equivalent to four (2) days shall be granted to the teaching and non-teaching personnel who will participate in the activity subject to existing guidelines on the grant of service credits and Compensatory Time-off.
- Participants are advised to bring their tents, sleeping gears, smart casual clothes and Type A uniform (polo, long pants and red neckerchiefs) and other personal belongings.
