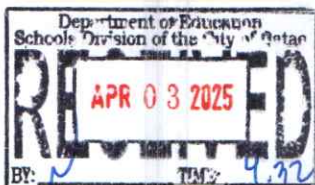

Agenda Item	Title: Proposed Granting of MMSU Excellence Awards to Graduating Senior High School Students
Background	<p>The Mariano Marcos State University has been excelling in academics, sports, and culture for the past 46 years. With quality education, graduates have displayed exemplary performance in their respective professions. Every year, the university grants academic degrees to thousands of students. On top of the academic honors that some graduating students obtain, respective colleges award their graduating students to recognize their excellence in curricular and extra-curricular activities. The diversity of their competence, skills, and talents make the graduates more globally competitive and industry ready.</p> <p>This year, the university intends to recognize the achievements of graduating Senior High School students from the various high schools of the Province of Ilocos Norte. The award to be granted to qualified students will be known as MMSU Excellence Awards. This initiative of MMSU aims to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. recognize the achievements of graduating Senior High School students in academics, sports, culture, and the arts;2. encourage graduating students to pursue higher education and hone their talents and skills; and3. strengthen the partnership between MMSU and the Department of Education
Particulars	<p>The awards to be given will be as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. MMSU Excellence Award in Academics (per school)2. MMSU Excellence Award in Sports (inclusive of all sports and athletic events)3. MMSU Excellence Award in Culture and the Arts<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. Musicb. Dancec. Drama and Theater Artsd. Literary Artse. Visual Arts



GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. Each public Senior High School in the Divisions of Ilocos Norte, Laoag City, and City of Batac is entitled to one awardee for the MMSU Excellence Award in Academics.
2. The MMSU Excellence Awards in Sports will include all sports events. There will be a separate award for each athletic event where the students excel, in accordance with these guidelines.
3. For competitive events, the awardee should be a placer/medalist at the regional level or higher.
4. All activities participated in by the awardees must be sanctioned by the school.
5. The Schools Division Offices (Ilocos Norte, Laoag City, and City of Batac), shall determine the most qualified recipient for each award. The list of recipients shall be submitted to MMSU, through the Office of the President, at least ONE week prior to the school's graduation ceremony. For School Year 2023-2024, the list of awardees should be submitted to MMSU not later than May 22, 2024. For succeeding school years, the deadline for submission of the list of awardees will be communicated by MMSU to the Schools Division Offices.

SPECIFIC GUIDELINES

Guidelines in the selection of recipients of the MMSU Excellence Award in Academics

The awardee will be the student who obtained the highest general weighted average among the graduating students, regardless of track and strand.

Guidelines in the selection of recipients of the MMSU Excellence Award in Sports

- The award is given to a student who demonstrates exceptional athletic abilities, sportsmanship, and dedication to their chosen sport.
(individual, dual, or team sports)

-This award includes all sports and athletic events.

- The student should have won a medal in any of the athletic events at the regional, national, or international level within the duration of his/her Senior High School education.



Guidelines in the selection of recipients of the MMSU Excellence Award in Culture and the Arts

1. Music:

- The awardee must be a student who has demonstrated exceptional musical talent, skills, abilities and dedication, either in vocal music or instrumental music.
- The awardee should have achieved outstanding performances in concerts, competitions, or recitals.
- The awardee should have notable musical achievements, such as composing original songs, winning awards at the regional or national level, participating in prestigious events such as but not limited to Tanghalan ng Kampeon, Pilipinas Got Talent, The Voice, either as a solo artist or in group performance.

The student should have won a medal in any of the musical competitions at the regional, national, or international level within the duration of his/her Senior High School education.


2. Dance:

- The awardee must be a student who has shown exceptional technical proficiency, creativity, and artistic expression in dance.
- The awardee should have notable performances in regional, national, and/or international competitions, and have participated in renowned showcases, or productions.
- The awardee should have demonstrated growth and improvement in his/her dance skills over time like being able to do original dance compositions.

The student should have won a medal in any of the dance competitions at the regional, national, or international level within the duration of his/her Senior High School education.

3. Drama and Theater Arts:

- The awardee must be a student who possesses exceptional acting abilities, stage presence, and commitment to the craft.

	<p>- The awardee should have notable performances in plays, musicals, or theatrical productions.</p> <p>- The awardee should have taken on challenging roles, displayed versatility, and made positive contributions to the theater community.</p> <p>The awardee should have notable performances in regional, national, and/or international competitions, and have participated in renowned showcases, or productions.</p> <p>The student should have won a medal in any of the drama and theater arts competitions at the regional, national, or international level within the duration of his/her Senior High School education.</p> <p>4. Literary Arts:</p> <p>- The awardee must be a student who demonstrates exceptional writing and oratorical skills, creativity, and the ability to convey meaningful messages through his/her work.</p> <p>- The awardee should have notable participation and achievements in writing competitions (at least regional level), publications (books, magazines, journals, newspapers, school papers, and similar platforms), or oratorical contests (at least regional level).</p> <p>- The awardee should have a strong command of language, originality in their writing, and a passion for literature.</p> <p>The student should have won a medal in any literary arts competition at the regional, national, or international level within the duration of his/her Senior High School education.</p> <p>5. Visual Arts:</p> <p>- The awardee must be a student who possesses exceptional artistic skills, creativity, and the ability to communicate through visual media.</p> <p>- The awardee should have notable artworks, such as paintings, sculptures, drawings, photography, or digital art to his/her credit.</p> <p>- The awardee should have a unique artistic style, technical proficiency, and a strong portfolio of artworks.</p>

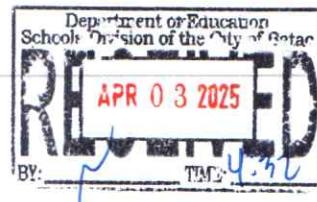
