**2025 ECO-LYMPICS ILOCOS:
PROVINCIAL WILDLIFE QUIZ BOWL**

COMPETITION MECHANICS

1. This quiz bowl shall be open to all public and private high school students in the three division of Ilocos Norte (DepEd Ilocos Norte, DepEd Laoag, DepEd Batac).
2. Each participating school shall be represented by one team of two bona fide students.
3. Each division will be represented by:
 - A. DepEd Ilocos Norte- 6 participating schools
 - B. DepEd Laoag- 3 participating schools
 - C. DepEd Batac- 3 participating schools ✓
4. Each participating school shall be responsible for their own transportation to and from the venue.
5. The questions used in this quiz bowl are based on the subjects of basic biology, ecology, Philippine wildlife, Philippine biogeography, environmental laws, and environmental issues.
6. This quiz bowl shall have three rounds namely Easy, Average, and Difficult Round.
7. Wrong spelling is considered a wrong answer.
8. Cheating in any form shall automatically disqualify a team.
9. Clarifications, questions, and protests should be immediately addressed to the Board of Judges **before** the next question is asked otherwise these shall be considered void.
10. The decision of the Board of Judges shall be final and irrevocable.
 - A. *Easy Round*
 - a.) This round shall consist of 10 questions.
 - b.) Each question shall be asked by the Quiz Master and shall only be repeated once.
 - c.) All teams shall only be given 10-15 seconds after each question to decide on their final answers, which must be legibly written on the board provided by the organizers.
 - d.) The Quiz Master shall signal the start and end of the 10-second period.
 - e.) Each **correct answer** will be equivalent to **one** (1) point.
 - f.) Only the 10 teams with the highest scores at the end of this round shall qualify for the next round.
 - g.) In case of a tie, a set of three tie-breaker questions shall be asked among the teams that are tied. Each correct answer will be equivalent to one point. The team with the most number of correct answers after three questions will qualify for the next round. However, if the tie is not broken after three questions, both (or all) teams that are tied will qualify for the next round.
 - B. *Average Round*
 - a.) All qualified teams shall begin this round with the total points each team earned during the Elimination Round, excluding the points earned during a tie-breaker set.
 - b.) This round shall consist of 10 questions.
 - c.) Each question shall be asked by the Quiz Master and shall only be repeated once.
 - d.) All teams shall only be given 10 seconds after each question to decide on their final answers, which must be legibly written on the board provided by the organizers.
 - e.) The Quiz Master shall signal the start and end of the 10-15 second period.
 - f.) Each **correct answer** will be equivalent to **two** (2) points.

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- g.) Only the teams with the passing scores at the end of this round shall qualify for the final round.

C. Difficult Round

- a.) All qualified teams shall begin this round with the total points each team accumulated after the first two rounds.
- b.) This round shall consist of 10 questions.
- c.) Each question shall be asked by the Quiz Master and shall only be repeated once.
- d.) All teams shall only be given 10-15 seconds after each question to decide on their final answers, which must be legibly written on the board provided by the organizers.
- e.) The Quiz Master shall signal the start and end of the 10-15 second period.
- f.) Each **correct answer** will be equivalent to **three (3)** points.
- g.) The team with the highest score at the end of this round shall be declared the grand champion of the **Provincial Wildlife Quiz Bowl**.
- h.) In case of a tie, tie-breaker questions shall be asked among the teams that are tied. The team to give the first correct answer shall be the winner of the tie-breaker round. If more than two teams are tied, any team to give an incorrect answer shall immediately be dropped out of the tie-breaker round.

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The **top three teams** will also have the opportunity to represent the province/region to the National Wildlife Quiz Bowl on 28-29 November 2025, 1AM at Dumaguete City, Negros Oriental.

PRIZES

The first (1st), second (2nd) and third (3rd) placers will receive
Certificate of Recognition and cash prize as follows:

First – P10,000.00

Second – P6,000.00

Third – P4,000.00

Certificate of Recognition will be given to the coaches of the winning students.

All non-winning teams will receive a **Certificate of Participation and a Consolation Prize of one thousand pesos (P1,000.00).**
