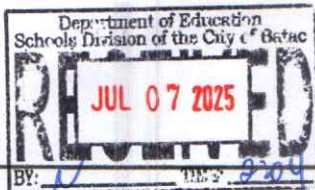

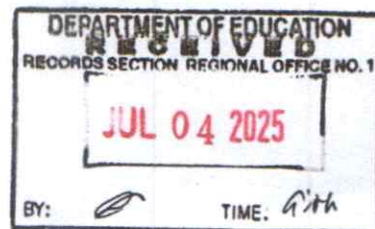

This is in reference to the **DepEd Memorandum No. 022, s. 2021** entitled *Observance of National Celebrations on Advocacy Programs in Support to Inclusive Education*, relative to the conduct of the 47th National Disability Rights Week that will be led by the National Council on Disability Affairs (NCDA) with the theme, *Innovation for Inclusion: Building Inclusive Communities* from July 17 to 23, 2025.

This Department encourages all schools, especially those implementing Special Needs Education (SNED) programs, to conduct **any of the following suggested school-based activities during the week:**

- a. Schools shall incorporate themes of inclusion and disability rights into their flag ceremonies, featuring messages for learners with disabilities, school officials, or learner representatives.
- b. Set up exhibits, showcasing assistive technology, inclusive instructional materials, and learner-led initiatives that promote accessibility and innovative thinking for inclusion.
- c. Create a visual display or bulletin board with student messages, photographs of Person with Disability (PWD) advocates, and information about building inclusive communities.
- d. Organize cultural activities that highlight the talents of students with and without disabilities, promoting an appreciation for diversity and inclusion.
- e. Holding sports fest, recitals, and activities featuring success stories of learners with disabilities;
- f. Basic orientation sessions in Filipino Sign Language (FSL) or Braille can be provided for learners as well as teachers to enhance their awareness of inclusive communication techniques.
- g. Organize a community-wide pledge signing to demonstrate commitment to inclusive practices and support learners with disabilities.
- h. Organizing day camp to provide opportunities for children and youth with disabilities to explore and learn while having fun and to highlight the Celebration of National Disability Rights Week.
