To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Education Supervisors Unit and Section Heads Public and Private Elementary School Heads All Others Concerned

- Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 1078, s. 2025 regarding the Resumption of the School-Based Immunization Program, the Schools Division of the City of Batac, in partnership with the City Health Office will implement the abovementioned program in all public and private schools of the City of Batac on August 2025.

 - b. Human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine- Grade 4 female learners.
- Parental Consent of eligible learners must be secured prior to the conduct of the said activity. Furthermore, all schools are advised to submit a report of learners who received the vaccine on or before September 30, 2025 thru the template herein attached for reference.





This initiative aims to protect school-aged children from vaccine-preventable diseases (VPDs) such as measles, rubella, tetanus, diphtheria, and human papillomavirus (HPV), thereby promoting the health and well-being of our school learners.

As of July 26, 2025 (Morbidity Week 30), the Regional Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit reported 257 suspected measles-rubella (MR) cases in Region I. This is 89% higher than the number of cases reported in the same period in 2024, and this increase was observed in all provinces. 







