**CONTINUATION OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SCHOOL-BASED
IMMUNIZATION PROGRAM**

1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 1078, s. 2025 regarding the Resumption of the School-Based Immunization Program, the Schools Division of the City of Batac, in partnership with the City Health Office will implement the above-mentioned program in all public and private schools of the City of Batac on August 2025.
2. This activity aims to protect school-aged children from vaccine-preventable diseases such as measles, rubella, tetanus, diphtheria and human papillomavirus to ensure their health and well-being.
3. The target beneficiaries of the said program are as follows:
 - a. Measles, Rubella, Tetanus, Diphtheria (MR-Td) vaccine- Grades 1 and 7 learners; and
 - b. Human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine- Grade 4 female learners.
4. Parental Consent of eligible learners must be secured prior to the conduct of the said activity. Furthermore, all schools are advised to submit a report of learners who received the vaccine on or before September 30, 2025 thru the template herein attached for reference.

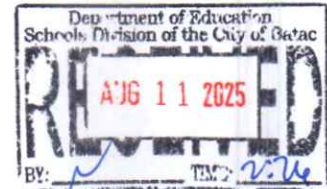

Dear **Dir. Aquino**:

This Office, through the National Immunization Program (NIP), in collaboration with your Department, will resume the implementation of the **School-Based Immunization (SBI) Program** in schools and communities. This initiative aims to protect school-aged children from vaccine-preventable diseases (VPDs) such as measles, rubella, tetanus, diphtheria, and human papillomavirus (HPV), thereby promoting the health and well-being of our school learners.

As of July 26, 2025 (Morbidity Week 30), the Regional Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit reported 257 suspected measles-rubella (MR) cases in Region I. This is 89% higher than the number of cases reported in the same period in 2024, and this increase was observed in all provinces. In line with this, we respectfully request your assistance in the following:

In line with this, we respectfully request your assistance in the following:

- **Coordination** with the provincial, city and municipal health officers to ensure smooth implementation of *Bakuna Eskwela*;
- **Securing parental consent** for students eligible for vaccination;
- **Submission of the actual number of students enrolled in Grades 1, 4, and 7** in public schools, to help us plan for vaccine supply and logistics.

We remain committed to intensifying immunization efforts and recognize the vital role of your leadership and support.

Ito ay 89% na mas mataas kaysa sa bilang ng mga kasong naiulat sa kaparehong panahon noong 2024, at ang pagtaas na ito ay naitala sa lahat ng lalawigan.
