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HUMAN PAPILLOMA VIRUS (HPV) VACCINATION FOR SY 2025-2026

The Office of the Presidential Assistant for Northern Luzon headed by Asec. Ana Carmela V. Remigio, alongside with the Department of Health shall conduct the *Ligtas sa Cervical Cancer: Para sa Bawat Babae at Mag-ina (PBBM-IN)* campaign on September 16-19 and 22, 2025, 8:00 AM-5:00 PM at Catalino Acosta Memorial Elementary School.

The activity aims to address the pressing issue of Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) in the Philippines by administering the HPV Vaccine to eligible 9-14 year-old female learners of both public and private schools of the division.

Learners eligible to receive the above-mentioned vaccination must bring their signed consent form, identification card and must be accompanied by their parent or guardian.

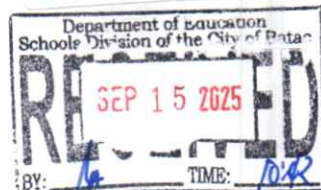
