REITERATION OF IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES FOR THE ARAL READING PROGRAM FOR SY 2025-2026

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent

- In line with the Department of Education's thrust to strengthen foundational literacy and address learning gaps, the Department of Education Regional Office I hereby reiterates the provisions of various memoranda relative to the implementation of the Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning (ARAL) Reading Program for School Year 2025-2026.
- 2. For Grades 2 to 10, the Program shall commence not later than September 15, 2025, in accordance with established timelines and readiness indicators.
- To ensure consistent implementation, the following provisions must be strictly observed:
 - DepEd Memorandum No. 64, s. 2025

Implementing Guidelines for the Academic Reovery and Accessible Learning (ARAL) Program in Reading for Key Stage 103

- A. Phased Implementation:
 - 1. For Grade 1, the Program shall begin in the third quarter of SY 2025-
 - 2. For Grades 2 and 3, the Program shall begin in the second quarter of SY 2025-2026.
 - 3. For Grades 4-10, the Program shall start in the second quarter of SY 2025-2026 or earlier, as soon as the school has satisfied the readiness indicators
- B. Eligible ARAL Reading Tutors (as per DepEd Order No. 18, s. 2025, Item
 - 1. DepEd teachers, provided they will not serve as tutors of their own learners:
 - 2. Pre-service teachers; and
 - 3. Other qualified individuals with relevant experience, competence, and good moral character. Preference shall be given to those with prior training in reading remediation or foundational literacy stages.

A. The following shall serve as Midline Assessment Tools for learners enrolled in the ARAL Reading Program:

1. Functional Literacy Assessment Tool (FLAT) for Grades 1-6 (Mother Tongue, English, and Filipino); and

2. Language Enhancement Through Reading Assessment (LETRA) for Grades 7-10 (English and Filipino)

III. Joint Memorandum of the Office of the Undersecretary and Chief of Staff, the Office of Undersecretary for Learning Systems, and the Office of the Undersecretary for Finance

- A. Program funds shall be utilized for activities and expenses related to ARAL implementation, including but not limited to:
 - 1. Provision and distribution of Teacher and Learner Resources;
 - 2. Orientation activities;
 - 3. Training activities (including payments for external resource persons);
 - 4. School Readiness and Responsiveness Audit
 - 5. Monitoring and evaluation activities;
 - Other program-related expenses consistent with program guidelines, subject to existing budgeting, accounting, auditing, and procurement rules and regulations.
- Downloaded funds from the Regional Office earmarked as "Program Support Funds for the Implementation of ARAL-Reading Program" shall carry the same eligible expenses. Schools Division Offices (SDOs) are authorized to strategically utilize these funds in response to their local needs and priorities.
- Orientation for school heads and training for tutors may be conducted through various modalities (face-to-face, blended, or online), ensuring that 100% of school heads and tutors are capacitated. No tutor shall be allowed to conduct ARAL sessions without prior training.
- 6. The technical specifications of the teaching-learning materials are contained in DM-OULS-2025-051.
- All SDOs are directed to accomplish and submit the prescribed form (soft copy) attached to this Memorandum on or before the specified deadline and submit the same to the Regional Office through email at clmd.region1@deped.gov.ph with the subject ARAL Reading Implementation.
