1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 647, s. 1990, declaring October as National Statistics Month (NSM), and in support of the Philippine Statistics Authority's initiatives to promote statistical literacy and awareness, as well as the numeracy program of the Schools Division of the City of Batac, this Division will celebrate the 36th NSM this October 2025 through various activities collectively known as *STATalino*.
2. *STATalino* aims to:
 - a. promote statistical literacy and appreciation among learners through creative, contextualized, and meaningful activities;
 - b. strengthen learners' oral, written, and visual communication skills in expressing statistical ideas;
 - c. deepen learners' understanding of statistical concepts and their real-life applications;
 - d. recognize the contributions of personalities behind the development of statistical theories and methods; and
 - e. encourage schools to analyze, present, and communicate school data effectively to their stakeholders.
3. Meanwhile, the Ilocos Norte Provincial Statistics Committee invites secondary schools to participate in the provincial competitions. Enclosure 2. General Guidelines in the Implementation of Project *STATalino*

1. Participation

- a. All public elementary and secondary schools in the Division are enjoined to actively participate in the celebration of the National Statistics Month (NSM).
- b. Schools may design their own school-based activities aligned with the weekly themes and sample activities provided.

2. Integration of Theme

- a. The official theme shall be highlighted in all activities and communication materials (banners, posters, social media posts, programs).
- b. Teachers are encouraged to integrate statistics-related discussions into their lessons where appropriate.

3. Flexibility of Activities

- a. Suggested sample activities may be adopted, modified, or innovated based on the school context, resources, and learners' needs.
- b. Schools may combine activities or implement them per week depending on schedule and feasibility.

4. Inclusivity

- a. Activities should ensure the participation of all learners, regardless of grade level, gender, or learning ability.
- b. Contest rules and criteria (if any) must be fair, transparent, and age-appropriate.

5. Documentation and Reporting

- a. Schools shall document their activities through photos, write-ups, or videos.
- b. A terminal report highlighting the activities, best practices, and challenges encountered shall be prepared and submitted to the Division Office through the assigned focal person.
- c. The terminal report shall be included in the Annual Accomplishment of the School-Based Mathematics Program.

6. Monitoring

- a. Implementation shall be monitored by the School Heads and the Division Monitoring Team.
- b. Schools are encouraged to use the provided monitoring tool for consistency and proper documentation.

7. Recognition

- a. Outstanding school-based initiatives and best practices shall be recognized at the Division level as part of the Project UNO Awards.


