- Pursuant to Executive Order No. 44, s. 1998, which declares the Philippine Youth Games-Batang Pinoy as the national sports development program for children and serves as a feeder program for higher-level competitions such as the Palarona Pambansa and other national athletic meets, the Schools Division of the City of Batac (SDCB) will participate in the 2025 Batang Pinoy, an annual sports event to be hosted by General Santos City on October 25-30, 2025.


