





# PARADA ILOCA-LOCANA 2025 FLOAT COMPETITION GUIDELINES

- The concept or theme for the float must clearly interpret this year's official theme, "Encantadia" by showcasing elements of Ilocano Halloween and highlighting the Semana ti Ar-Aria values and cultural traditions of our province or locality.
- Assembly time for all parade participants (dancers, floats, and members of the LGU) is 5:00 PM at the Bypass Road.
- 3. The parade will start at 6:00 PM on October 31, 2025, traversing Bypass Road and Ablan Avenue, and ending in front of the Marcos Stadium.
- 4. Floats must be constructed on top of a **vehicle** or a **trailer pulled by a vehicle**. Ensure stability and proper weight distribution.
- The total height of the float must **not exceed 14 feet**, including all decorative elements.
- All floats must include a working onboard sound system playing thematic Halloween or Semana ti Ar-Aria music. Music must align with the float's concept and overall mood.
- 7. Lighting must be treated as a primary design component, not just an accessory. Lights should highlight the structure, enhance details, and bring thematic elements to life.
  - Use of LED strips, spotlights, colored filters, animated lights, and blacklight effects is encouraged.
  - b. Consider **synchronized lighting sequences** that interact with the soundtrack or narrative of your float.
  - c. Employ **uplighting** and **backlighting** to create dramatic silhouettes and depth.
- 8. Lighting colors must complement the **overall color scheme and concept** of the float. Avoid overly harsh or distracting color combinations unless intentional for thematic effect.
- 9. Use lighting to **engage the audience**—for example, motion-triggered lights, glowing elements that respond to sound, or projected illusions.
- 10. All lighting fixtures must be securely fastened and should not pose a hazard to the public or riders. Battery-powered or generator-powered setups are permitted, provided they are safely operated.
