MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

KNOWALL MEN BY THESE PRESENT

This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) is made and entered into by and between:

The **DEPARTMENT OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY, REGIONAL OFFICE 1**, a national government agency created and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with office address at DMMMSU Mid-La Union Campus, Catbangan, City of San Fernando City, La Union, represented by its Regional Director, **DR. TERESITA A. TABAOG**, herein referred to as "**DOST-1;**"

- and -

The **DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, REGIONAL OFFICE 1**, a national government agency created and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with office address at Government Center, Sevilla, San Fernando City, La Union, represented by its Regional Director, **TOLENTINO G. AQUINO**, herein referred to as "**DEPED RO1.**"

- WITNESSETH -

WHEREAS, **DOST-I** is mandated under Executive Order No. 128 to provide central direction, leadership and coordination of scientific and technological efforts and ensure that the results therefrom are geared and utilized in areas of maximum economic and social benefits for the people.

WHEREAS, Proclamation No. 169 (1993) institutionalized the **National Science and Technology Week (NSTW)** as an annual event, which is aimed at providing an opportunity to focus regional and national attention on the contribution of science and technology to national development and to give recognition and appreciation to outstanding accomplishments and personalities in science and technology.

WHEREAS, the **NSTW 2025**, a national event, which will be held in Laoag City, Ilocos Norte, on November 18-21, 2025. Significant achievements, current technologies, and interactive exhibits aligned with the DOST four pillars will be showcased.

WHEREAS, the **NSTW** includes activities for various fields like basic and applied research, technology transfer, technology commercialization and S&T promotion; scientific meetings, technical and investment forums, technology demonstrations, and technical tours.

WHEREAS, The **DEPED RO1** shall formulate, implement, and coordinate policies, plans, programs and projects in the areas of formal and non-formal basic education. It supervises all elementary and secondary education institutions, including alternative learning systems, both public and private; and provides for the establishment and maintenance of a complete, adequate, and integrated system of basic education relevant to the goals of national development.

WHEREAS, the parties recognize the importance of partnership and coordination among key players and stakeholders in the field of Science, Technology and Innovation to achieve a resilient, smart, inclusive, and sustainable Philippines.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the preceding premises, the parties hereby agree to collaborate for the successful conduct of the event, according to the following terms:

ARTICLE I GENERAL PROVISIONS

- a) The parties shall contribute to the attainment of the expected outcomes of the Event;
- b) The parties commit to promote the Event through their respective communication channels, including social media platforms, websites, and press releases.
- c) the parties shall commit to promote the various technologies showcased during the Event;
- d) Attend to meetings that will be held to ensure seamless coordination and to monitor progress towards the event; and
- e) Acknowledge that any financial requirements for the activities under this MOU shall be subject to the availability of funds and the budgetary provisions of each party.

ARTICLE II DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF DOST-I

- 1. Lead, organize and coordinate the event through close collaboration with partner agencies;
- 2. Communicate timely updates and information to the partner agencies to ensure seamless and successful execution of the event;
- 3. Provide the necessary resources and support including the arrangement of venues, equipment, and logistics;

ARTICLE III DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF DEPED RO1

- 1. Extend invitations to its networks and stakeholders, ensuring broad participation from relevant sectors, including but not limited to academe, government, and the private education sector;
- 2. Encourage officials and employees to attend the Opening Ceremony, Closing Ceremony, Evening Cultural Activities, and Plenary Sessions/Exhibits.

3. Engage students, especially, Senior High Schools particularly in STEM strands to participate in the Event.
4. Promote the and participate in the technology exhibits that will be showcased during the Event.
- Remove* #5. Recommend experts and/or resource persons to deliver talks, facilitate workshops, and deliver presentations and on _____-related topics.

ARTICLE IV DATA PRIVACY AND CONFIDENTIALITY

The parties agree to comply with the Data Privacy Act of 2012 (R.A. No. 10173) in handling sensitive and proprietary information relative to product formulations, business models, and research outputs. Any confidential data shared shall not be disclosed to third parties without the written consent of the originating entity.

These obligations shall apply to all confidential information exchanged between the parties, including any exchanges occurred during the preliminary discussions, and shall remain in effect notwithstanding the termination or expiry of this MOU.

ARTICLE V EFFECTIVITY AND DURATION

This Agreement shall take effect upon signing of the parties involved, and shall remain in force until December 31, 2025, unless otherwise earlier modified or amended in writing by mutual consent of the parties.

ARTICLE VI AMENDMENT AND TERMINATION

Any amendment/s shall be communicated only through a written agreement duly signed by the parties. Unless otherwise specified, such amendments shall take effect upon execution. Either party may terminate this MOU, with or without cause, by serving a written notice of termination to the other party. Said termination by either party shall become effective after the lapse of thirty (30) days following the receipt of such written notice by the other party. Within thirty (30) days upon termination and wherever applicable, all personal data transmitted pursuant to this MOU shall be returned, destroyed, or disposed of in accordance with the relevant laws or any other agreement.

ARTICLE VII DISPUTE RESOLUTION

In the event of dispute or difference of any kind whatsoever arising out of or relating to this Agreement, the parties shall, exercise their best efforts to resolve the dispute or difference by mutual consultation as soon as possible. In case best efforts fail, the dispute or difference shall be resolved following the implementing rules and regulations of Republic Act No. 9285 or the Alternative Dispute Resolution Act of 2004. The law of the arbitration shall

be Philippine law while the seat of arbitration shall be in the Philippines. The number of arbitrators shall be agreed upon by the parties.

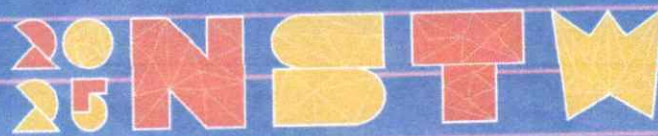
