

- This is in reference to the enclosed DepEd Memorandum dated November 11, 2025 on the Administration of the Middle-of-School-Year (MOSY) Assessments for the Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning (ARAL) Program. All schools are directed to comply with the provisions, timelines, and instructions for the conduct of the MOSY assessments as part of the midyear monitoring of learners' progress in literacy and reading.
- The MOSY assessments, implemented pursuant to Republic Act No. 12028, DepEd Order No. 18, s. 2025, and DepEd Memorandum No. 64, s. 2025, shall be administered to all learners from Grades 1 to 10 within the specified testing windows for School Year 2025-2026. These assessments are essential in determining learners' literacy performance and guiding teachers and tutors in planning appropriate interventions under the ARAL Program.
- 3. All public schools across Region 1 shall administer the MOSY assessments within the prescribed period, regardless of the commencement of their ARAL implementation or the number of sessions conducted. Schools that have already completed the MOSY assessment administration prior to the issuance of this memorandum are not required to repeat the process but must ensure the proper encoding and submission of results.
- The testing periods and required assessment tools are provided below, as specified in the national memorandum:




- 1. This is in reference to the enclosed DepEd Memorandum dated November 11, 2025 on the Administration of the Middle-of-the-School-Year (MOSY) Assessments for the Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning (ARAL) Program. All Schools Division Offices and schools are directed to comply with the provisions, timelines, and instructions for the conduct of MOSY assessments as part of the midyear monitoring of learners' progress in literacy and reading.
- 2. The MOSY assessments, implemented pursuant to Republic Act No. 12028, DepEd Order No. 18, s. 2025, and DepEd Memorandum No. 64, s. 2025, shall be administered to all learners from Grades 1 to 10 within the specified testing windows for School Year 2025–2026. These assessments are essential in determining learners' literacy performance and guiding teachers and tutors in planning appropriate interventions under the ARAL Program.
- 3. All public schools across Region I shall administer the MOSY assessments within the prescribed period, regardless of the commencement of their ARAL implementation or the number of sessions conducted. Schools that have already completed the MOSY assessment administration prior to the issuance of this memorandum are not required to repeat the process but must ensure the proper encoding and submission of results.





This Memorandum provides guidance on the conduct of the middle-of-the-school-year (MOSY) assessments for the implementation of the Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning (ARAL) Program in accordance with Republic Act No. 12028<sup>1</sup>, its Implementing Rules and Regulations, and DepEd Order (DO) No. 18, s. 2025,<sup>2</sup> and DepEd Memorandum (DM) No. 64, s. 2025<sup>3</sup>.

The MOSY assessments shall be administered to Grades 1 to 10 learners as part of the ongoing implementation of the ARAL Program.

All schools shall administer the MOSY assessments within the prescribed testing window, irrespective of the program's start date or the number of sessions completed. Schools that have administered the MOSY assessments prior to the issuance of this Memorandum shall no longer be required to do so again.

Table 1 presents the details of the administration of the MOSY assessments for School Year 2025-2026.

The MOSY results of the CRLA for Grade 1 shall determine their participation in the ARAL Program, while for Grades 2 to 10, the results shall guide tutors and teachers in identifying the appropriate next steps for each learner.
