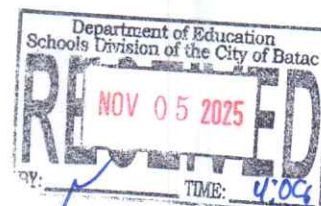

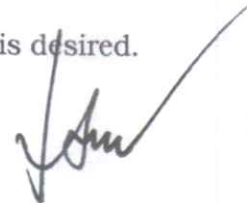

- Each of the researcher-participant shall render 10-minute live PowerPoint presentation which focuses on the research findings, utilization and effectiveness following the prescribed outline:

Outline	Content
Title of the Study (1 slide)	Title of the Study, Researcher/s, workstation, Division Office
Introduction/Rationale/Background (2 slides)	Description of the problem or issue that inspired the researcher/s to conduct the study
Statement of the Problem (1 slide)	Research questions
Research Methods (2 slides)	Research design, respondents, locale and ethical considerations
Results/ Findings and Implementation (2 slides)	Research outcomes and conclusion, graphs and/or pictures for easy recognition
Intervention/ Output/ Recommendation (2 slides)	Description of the intervention/ strategy/ output and endorsement for future utilization
Pictures and other Documentations (2 slides)	Pictures/Documents during the conduct and implementation of the study

- A 10-minute Q&A shall follow every presentation.
- Panelists are invited judges from the Academe.
- The presentation shall revolve around the highlights of the study, specifically on how the study contributes to DepEd's organizational outcomes.
- The criteria for the selection are as follows:
