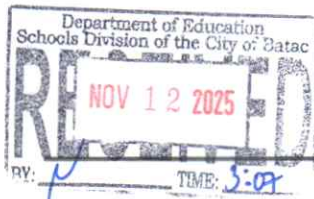

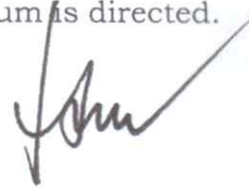
**CONDUCT OF THE REGIONAL APPRECIATION PROGRAM FOR
