Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 1680, s. 2025, the Department of Education (DepEd) through the Office of the Undersecretary for Learning Systems, issues the enclosed Advisory on the conduct of Work Immersion on non-class days, specifically, DepEd Orders No. 30, s. 2017 and No. 13, s. 2018 which contain no explicit restrictions preventing learners from undergoing Work Immersion during weekends and holidays.
- 2. In line with this, schools have the flexibility to schedule Work Immersion activities on weekends and holidays to efficiently meet the required hours.
- 3. The schedules must be adhered to on a voluntary basis. Written parent or legal guardian consent must be secured before the immersion activities scheduled on a weekend or holiday.



#### ADVISORY ON THE CONDUCT OF WORK IMMERSION

To: Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Office of the Undersecretary for Learning Systems, issues the enclosed Advisory on the conduct of Work Immersion on non-class days. Specifically, DepEd Orders No. 30 s. 2017 and No. 13 s. 2018 contain no explicit restrictions preventing learners from undergoing Work Immersion during weekends and holidays.
- 2. In line with this clarification, schools have the flexibility to schedule Work Immersion activities on weekends and holidays to efficiently meet the required hours. This can be highly beneficial for both students and Partner Institutions. This event is officially rescheduled to January 2026. The specific date will be announced through a separate memorandum.
- 3. While this flexibility is allowed, the schedules must be adhered to on a voluntary basis. Crucially, written parent or legal guardian consent must be secured before the immersion activities are conducted on a weekend or holiday.



Specifically, DepEd Orders No. 30 s. 2017 and No. 13 s. 2018 contain no explicit restrictions preventing learners from undergoing Work Immersion during weekends or holidays.
