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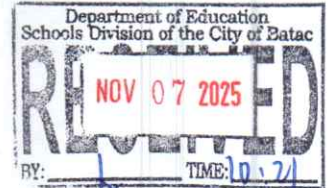

Warm greetings from the Alumni Association of the MMSU College of Teacher Education!



That advantage, however, is fast deteriorating as shown in recent studies. In the 2022 Program for International Assessment (PISA), the Philippines ranked No.77 in Reading out of 80 countries. In that same year in the 2022 edition of the English language index (ELI) of the international education company, Education First (EF), the Philippines slipped four notches down to 22nd in English Language Proficiency out of 111 countries.

To help abate this situation, the MMSU CTEAA is taking a humble but active role by launching a search for "Marshall Felix L. Josue Most Outstanding English Teacher of Ilocos Norte 2026." Applicants should have been in the service for at least five (5) years and with at least **Very Satisfactory** Performance Rating in the last three (3) years.

Supporting Documents: Service Record and Performance Rating in the last 3 years

Applicants should be nominated by their immediate head/supervisor/colleague.

All supporting documents should be certified by the head of the school as True Copy of the original.

Submit in triplicate copies the nomination form and supporting documents.
