**INVITATION TO JOIN REGIONAL ADVENTURE CAMP OF THE GIRL SCOUTS
OF THE PHILIPPINES NORTHERN LUZON**

1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 214, s. 2026, the Schools Division of the City of Batac informs the conduct of the Regional Adventure Camp organized by the Girl Scouts of the Philippines (GSP) Northern Luzon scheduled for March 7-8, 2026 (Saturday and Sunday) at Zoobic Forest Adventure Park, Subic Bay Freeport Zone, Subic, Zambales.
2. The activity aims to promote teamwork, leadership, personal growth, and environmental awareness through outdoor and experiential learning activities. A key highlight of the camp is the interaction with members of the Aeta community, focusing on traditional knowledge and jungle survival skills.
3. Expected participants are Junior Girl Scouts (grades 4 to 6) and Senior/Cadet Girl Scouts (grades 7 to 12) along with their Troop Leaders (Teachers/Adult Chaperons).
4. While this Office encourages participation in scouting activities that build resilience and confidence, School Heads are reminded to ensure strict compliance with the following:
 - Parental Consent: Written consent from parents or guardians must be secured for all learner participants.
 - Non-Disruption-of-Classes Policy: Participation must adhere to DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 to ensure no classes are missed or disrupted.
 - Service Credits: Since the activity falls on a weekend, eligible teacher-participants may be granted Service Credits or Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) subject to existing DepEd and CSC rules and regulations.





Hence, we seek your kind endorsement and approval for the participation of our Girl Scouts along with their Troop Leaders, Sir.


