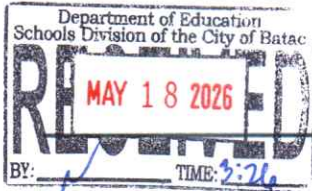

**CONDUCT OF SURVEY ON THE TYPE OF COOKING FACILITY AVAILABLE
PER SCHOOL FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE
SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM (SBFP)**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. This refers to the attached Memorandum OM-OUGOPS-2026-08-01253 issued by the Office of the Undersecretary for Governance and Operations Department of Education – Central Office, dated April 27, 2026, for information and guidance.

DATE : April 27, 2026

In line with the different partnerships and initiatives from the other private and public agencies supporting the School-Based Feeding Program, the Governance and Operations Strand, through the Bureau of Learner Support Services – School Health Division-Nutrition and Hygiene Unit (BLSS-SHD-NHU) shall conduct a survey on the type of cooking facility available per school.

The survey aims to determine the schools with cooking facilities which use firewood or any alternative cooking equipment in preparing hot meals for the School-Based Feeding Program. This survey shall also be the basis of the possible recipient of the subsidized cookstove, hardware, and initial cylinder of gas.

This is in line with the possible partnership of DepEd and Envirofit International Inc., an Energy Technology Company and Carbon Project Developer which expressed their initiative to remove the critical barrier to enter for a school to be able to cook their meals on LPG through subsidized and supplied cookstove, hardware and initial cylinder of gas for a cost-free and efficient support to the SBFP.
