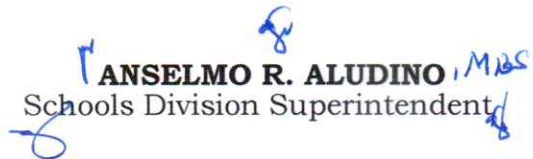

Expenses relative to the conduct of this activity – including board and lodging, meals, supplies and materials shall be charged against the downloaded FY 2026 HRDPSLCs Current Fund, while transportation, per diem and other incidental expenses shall be charged against downloaded funds to the SDO. In case downloaded funds are insufficient, it can be charged to the SDO MOOE or local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

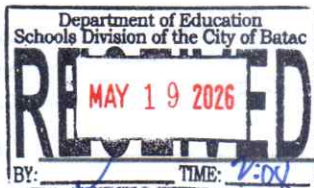
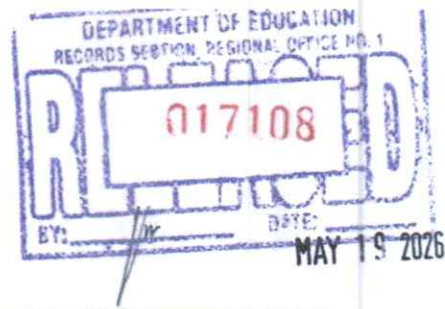
