1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 726 s. 2026 titled Strengthening the Security and Integrity of the Electronic Application for Private Schools (E-APS), all E-APS used shall update passwords. Passwords must include a combination of uppercase and lowercase letters, numbers, and special characters.
2. To maintain the integrity of the system, all users are reminded of the following:
 - a. Keep the passwords confidential and refrain from sharing with others;
 - b. Avoid using identifiable users such as names, birthdays, or common words as passwords;
 - c. Always log out of the system after its use, especially when using shared or public devices; and
 - d. Direct any technical concerns to E-APS HELPDESK or authorized personnel only for assistance.

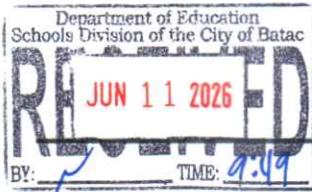

STRENGTHENING THE SECURITY AND INTEGRITY OF THE ELECTRONIC APPLICATION FOR PRIVATE SCHOOLS (E-APS)

To: Schools Division Superintendents

- Recent monitoring activities have detected attempts at unauthorized access and other login activities within the Electronic-Application for Private Schools (E-APS). While no system compromise has been confirmed, these incidents underscore the need to strengthen account security and protect the information stored in the system.
- In view thereof, this Office directs all E-APS users to update their passwords. New passwords shall contain a minimum of eight (8) characters and must include a combination of uppercase and lowercase letters, numbers, and special characters.
- To maintain the integrity of the system, all users are reminded of the following:
 - keep the passwords confidential and refrain from sharing with others;
 - avoid using identifiable users such as names, birthdays, or common words as passwords;
 - always log out of the system after its use, especially when using shared or public devices; and
 - direct any technical concerns to E-APS HELPDESK or authorized personnel only for assistance.
